Usually a birth parent chooses and arranges a private fostering placement and private foster carers do not hold parental responsibility.						
0 W	The Children Act defines 'relatives' in relation to a child as grandparent, brother, sister, uncle or auntie. They could be full or half relation and could be related by marriage. The term also includes a step-parent. A co-habit of the mother / father would not qualify as a relative; nor would extended family members such as a great aunt, great uncle or parent's cousins.
