If you are unsure what Private Fostering means please see the definition below.

“Private fostering occurs when a child or young person under the age of 16 (under 18 if disabled) is cared for, and provided with accommodation for more than 28 days, by an adult who is not a relative, by private arrangement between the parent and carer. The child would not be one that is looked after by a local authority under the Children Act. Usually a birth parent chooses and arranges a private fostering placement and private foster carers do not hold parental responsibility.

The Children Act defines ‘relatives’ in relation to a child as grandparent, brother, sister, uncle or auntie. They could be full or half relation and could be related by marriage. The term also includes a step-parent. A co-habit of the mother / father would not qualify as a relative; nor would extended family members such as a great aunt, great uncle or parent’s cousins.

If a child is living with a carer who is not a relative, it is a private fostering placement. The law requires parents, carers or anyone making a private fostering arrangement to contact the local authority about it. This is designed to ensure the child's safety. “
