

## Term 1a

*Course content:* Portraits - Artist influence = Holbein and Modigliani – developing portraits influenced by art from different periods.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Critical Understanding

## Term 1b

*Course content:* Sweets - Artist influence = English and Warhol – developing a primary observed drawing and a repeat decorated design.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Cultural Understanding

## Term 2a

*Course content:* The Modern World – Kandinsky – developing an abstract image based upon a musical style.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Competence

## Term 2b

*Course content:* Crime - Artist influence = Graffiti Art – developing a personal tag using image and lettering.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Creativity

## Term 3a

*Course content:* War and Peace - Artist influence = Rauschenberg – developing a multi-image image.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Competence

## Term 3b

*Course content:* Entertainment – Poster Art – developing a promotional poster for Blackpool.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Creativity

## **Term 1a**

*Course content:* Blackpool - Artist influence = Piper – developing a 4 square image based upon a map and decorated in various materials.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Creativity

## **Term 1b**

*Course content:* Sealife - Artist influence = Scarpace and Aborigine Art – developing images based on sea creatures using styles from different time periods.

## **Term 2a**

*Course content:* Ancient World - Artist influence = Egyptian Art – developing a modern interpretation of a figure using the Egyptian style.

## **Term 2b**

*Course content:* The Americas - Artist influence = Indiana – developing a non-figurative self-portrait.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Competence

## **Term 3a**

*Course content:* Descriptions - Artist influence = Various Illustrators – developing images from written descriptions.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Competence

## **Term 3b**

*Course content:* Environment - Artist influence = Hirst – developing symmetrical images based on insects.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using one of the four assessment concepts for KS3 Art = Creativity

## **Term 1a**

*Course content:* Crime & Punishment - British History – Banksy – developing a stencil image.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using the assessment criteria for KS2 Art = Mastery of technique

## **Term 1b**

*Course content:* Industrial Revolution - British History – recording observation drawings in sketchbooks.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using the assessment criteria for KS2 Art = Competence of drawing

## **Term 2a**

*Course content:* Deep Seas – developing art and design techniques with a range of materials.

*Assessment:* Work is assessed using the assessment criteria for KS2 Art = Creativity

## **Term 2b**

*Course content:* South American Rainforests - record observations in sketch books.
